





#### **Demographic Change**




- The Town of Ossining's Asian, Black and Latinx populations have increased over time.

#### **Age Distribution**




- The percentage of residents 55 and over has increased in the Town of Ossining from 14% to 45% from 1970 to 2018.

#### **Annual Average Daily Traffic**

- Route 9A has an AADT of 33,503 (2016), while Route 9 has an AADT of 18, 441.
- Croton Ave (NY 133), an important connector between the Town and Village, has an AADT of 8579.




#### Connectivity

The Briarcliff – Peekskill Trailway extends from Ryder Rd north into Cortlandt, where in connects with the Old Croton Aqueduct Trail, which eventually loops through the Village of Ossining. However, there are currently no viable east-west pedestrian connections within the Town of Ossining.



#### **Ossining Union Free School District: Enrollment Projections**


K-12 Enrollment 2009-2024



- From 2009 to 2018, Ossining UFSD gained 591 students (14%).
- From 2019 to 2024, Ossining UFSD is projected to lose 138 students (3%).
- Enrollment was projected to peak this year at 4,837 students.


#### **Zoning**

84% of the Town of Ossining is zoned as some form of single-family residential. 6% is zoned as multifamily. The remaining 10% is a mix of commercial zoning classes.



#### Land Use

Within the Town of Ossining, 22% of land area is dedicated to low density residential; 18% to medium density residential, and only 0.04% to high density residential. 5% of land area is dedicated to commercial.



#### **Open Space**


 Ryder Park is the primary publiclyaccessible park serving the eastern portion of the Town, while Cedar Lane Town Park is located in the western portion of the Town.





 Ossining falls primarily within the Pocantico and Saw Mill River watershed, although the northwest corner of the Town drains into the Croton River Basin.


